## <u>Initiation of discussion to change business operation in Continental Europe</u>

Mitsui Sumitomo Insurance Co., Ltd. ("MSI", President & CEO: Shinichiro Funabiki), a subsidiary of MS&AD Insurance Group Holdings, Inc., has initiated discussions on the intragroup merger of MS Amlin insurance SE (hereafter, AISE), and MSIG Insurance Europe AG (hereafter, MSIGEU), both a Continental European insurance subsidiary based in Belgium and Germany.

We aim to complete this merger around summer next year, subject to approval by the regulatory authorities, as well as consultations and decisions at local level.

#### 1. Background and purpose of merger

In 2007, MSI established German Desk in Cologne through its European subsidiary based in the UK, and started its operations in the Continental Europe, providing non-life insurance services to local corporates. With the expansion of our business in Continental Europe, we established MSIGEU in 2012. Today, MSIGEU provide insurance services mainly to local corporate and Japanese clients.

AISE became our overseas subsidiary through the acquisition of Amlin in 2016, expanding our traditional business base and providing insurance services mainly to local Small and Medium-sized Business market.

Since 2016, our business in the Continental Europe has been carried out by these two companies, and today, we have initiated this discussion aiming for the sustainable growth of our European business.

#### 2. Going Forward

The new company will become one of the larger insurance companies following the top five in Continental Europe in commercial and industrial market. We aim to further improve our presence, expand our business and strengthen profitability by pursuing synergies through integration, and strive to further improve customer service.
